The Board of Directors of South Bihar Power Distribution Company Limited in its 74<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 11.12.2017 vide its Resolution No.- 74-10 passed following modified provisions in erstwhile Bihar State Electricity Board's Notification No.- 810, dated 29.07.1994 regarding guideline for disposal of claim under clause-13 of the earlier HT agreement.

### Proposed Modification in erstwhile BSEB Not. No. 810 Dtd.29.7.1994

(In obedience of order dt. 13.05.2016 of Hon'ble Patna High Court in CWJC No. 5614 of 1999 with other CWJCs)

Para	Existing Provisions in Notification	Proposed Modified Provisions in Notification
2	The relief is allowable both for the demand charge and guaranteed energy charge as per clause 13 of the HT Agreement. However, the remission under clause 13 should be granted in proportion to the ability of the consumers to take or the Board to supply such power as provided in the said clause. The inability to take supply of electrical energy by the consumers for non-availability of raw materials, labour unrest without supporting documents or arising out due to Sunday and other holiday would not attract Clause 13 of the HT Agreement	The relief is allowable both for the demand charge and guaranteed energy charge as per clause 13 of the HT Agreement. However, the remission under clause 13 should be granted in proportion to the ability of the consumers to take or the Board to supply such power as provided in the said clause.  Remission in Demand Charges shall be calculated on the basis of following formula:-  $\frac{\text{Total KVA Charged} \times \text{Total Hours of non-Supply}}{\text{Total hours of power to be supplied}}$
3	Stoppage of supply can be either due to load shedding or system failure for reasons beyond Board's Control. Hence after careful consideration, it has been decided to grant proportionate relief for interruption of duration of 30 minutes and above	Deleted

6(a)	Claim made under Clause 13 of HT agreement in respect of current year will be disposed of within a period of 04 months by the competent authority of the Board from the date of filing of claim.	Disposal of the claim under clause 13 of the agreement will be done within 04 months from the date of the filing of the claim. DPS should be charged only for the maximum of four months or less depending on the date of disposal from the date of filing of the claim.


